Board requested vote - If we should adopt the PayHOA tool

- 1. We will quickly demo the tool during the meeting but request that you please go into it to see for yourself before the meeting.
- Hopefully you have already logged in, but if not please look for past email invite from PayHOA or email the board to verify your email and ask for another invite/activation email to be sent.
- 3. The board recommendation to adopt the tool as we believe it will foster better communication, allow us to do more with calendaring and streamline dues payment. We have worked this into the existing budget so are not asking for an increase in dues to pay for it.

Board requested vote - If the "small trail" be open for use

- There is a division in the neighborhood about whether to restrict access to the small trail
 closest to our neighborhood, see map. Those in favor of having it closed point out it is a
 wetlands area and should be protected. Those for keeping it open point out it has been a
 footpath trail for over 20 years and folks like to walk there to not have to worry about
 bikers.
- 2. Approximate trail is highlighted in yellow.



- 3. Wetlands much of the trail does cross what is designated as an "emerging wetland". Colorado considers wetlands, including emergent wetlands, as "Waters of the State" and regulates them under the state's dredge and fill authorization program and updated in 2024 when Colorado passed House Bill 24-1379. However, in the board's research, there are no restrictions against trails within the waters of the state designation.
- 4. The board recommendation Using the existing post, we post signs that restrict bike use on this trail (it would still be allowed on the upper trail), but continue to allow for walking. In addition we ask residents to please be cognizant that this area is a wetland and therefore to minimize disruption to soil or plants.

Neighbor requested vote - To change the Rules and Regulations to allow for recreational vehicles to park in driveways for part of the year.

The existing 72-hour rule doesn't let you keep your camper on your property if you're camping back-to-back weekends, which is common during the summer camping season. This creates a big hassle for many campers - especially considering the closest RV storage facility is a 40-minute round-trip drive from the neighborhood. During the week this can be an extra 1.5 hours of driving for a busy family camping on back-to-back weekends.

Residents should be allowed to park recreational travel trailers, on-truck camper, or recreational vehicles in their driveways <u>between Memorial Day and Labor Day</u>, provided that:

- 1. They are for recreational purposes only (i.e. no work trailers, trucks, etc).
- 2. They are road-worthy, registered, and are able to be moved.
- 3. They fit within a residence's driveway and are parked in the driveway, parking off of paved surfaces is not allowed.
- 4. They are not occupied.
- 5. The propane tanks are detached and stored away from the trailer.
- 6. They are not directly impeding the line of sight safety of their neighbors.

From Labor Day through Memorial Day, travel trailers, on-truck campers, and recreation vehicles must adhere to the 72 hour rule.

This new rule would require an amendment to the HOA Rules and Regulations to exclude travel trailers and recreational vehicles from the current 72-hour parking rule and create their own use case stated above. The existing rule would be amended to say:

Boats, campers, campers on or off a truck, mobile homes, trucks (other than pick-up trucks), recreational vehicles, horse trailers and other trailers, and other large vehicles shall not be permitted on any lots or streets in the subdivision for more than 72 hours unless they are stored or parked within a structure approved by the Design Review Committee for such purposes.

On or off-street parking (easement) for more than 24 hours or for extended periods of time is unsightly. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Parking off driveways or paved surfaces is not allowed.

Campers (trailers and on-truck) and recreational vehicles must adhere to the above rule between Labor Day and Memorial Day.

From Memorial Day to Labor Day, campers (trailers and on-truck) and recreational vehicles are allowed to park in the driveways as long as:

- 1. They are for recreational purposes only (i.e. no work trailers, trucks, etc).
- 2. They are road-worthy, currently registered, and are able to be moved.
- 3. They fit within a residence's driveway and are parked in the driveway, parking off of paved surfaces is not allowed.
- 4. They are not occupied.
- 5. The propane tanks are detached and stored away from the trailer.
- 6. They are not directly impeding the line of sight safety of their neighbors.
